INTRODUCTION

The NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF HOMOEOPATHY was established on 10th December 1975 at Kolkata as an autonomous Institute under the Ministry of H&FW, Government of India, and as to be a model academic institute of Homoeopathy in the country and registered under W.B. Society Registration Act XXVI of 1961. Presently the Institute is under the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India. The Institute was affiliated to the University of Calcutta up to session 2003-04 and from 2004-05 has been affiliated to the West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata. The Institute has been thrived for excellence in homoeopathic education, outstanding patient care and research activity. It imparts both Under Graduate (BHMS) and Post Graduate (MD) degree courses in Homoeopathy. The Institute has hospital having outpatient departments and a 100 bedded inpatients department along with laboratory facilities. Institute is the Regional Centre of Traditional medicine (Homoeopathy) in South East Asian countries.

OUR CAMPUS

Our Campus is located in one of the most planned and developed area of Salt Lake City, Kolkata, West Bengal. It is situated on a plot of land measuring about 16 acres at Block-GE, Sector -III, Salt Lake, Kolkata, 700106. Within the campus administrative and academic buildings, two UG boys' hostel , two girls' hostel , a huge Homoeopathic Hospital (which is being expanded from the present 100 IPD bed to 250), a modern library and information services, an auditorium with 600 seating capacity, quarters for Residential Medical Officers and sports-ground are arranged so picturesque that it is turning as a land mark spot for Kolkata and the country. The residential campus of the Institute is located on a plot of land measuring about 10 acres at JC block, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700098, in close vicinity to the main campus. An *International Hostel* with all modern facilities for accommodating students from abroad, separate PG hostels for boys and girls along with 23 residential

quarters for the employees of the Institute is also available in the same campus.

Courses

The Institute is conducting the 5½ years Degree Course in Homoeopathy viz., Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S.) and 3 years Postgraduate Course viz., Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy [M.D. (Hom.)] courses. The courses are full time regular courses and recognized by the Central Council of Homoeopathy and Govt. of India. The Institute is affiliated to The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata for both these courses.

Govt. of India, under Delhi Declaration has declared the National Institute of Homoeopathy, as the Regional Center for Traditional Medicine in South East Asian Region Countries. Govt. of India has enlisted National Institute of Homoeopathy, in the lists of Top Class Institutes in India.

TEACHING ACTIVITY

Since December 1987, the Institute has been conducting regular Degree course in Homoeopathy viz. Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery (B.H.M.S) affiliated to the University of Calcutta. BHMS Students from 16th batch onwards have been admitted under The West Bengal University of Health Sciences. 93 seats are available in BHMS Degree Course.

From the session 1998-1999 the Institute is conducting Postgraduate Course viz. Doctor of Medicine in Homoeopathy [M. D. (Hom.)] in three subjects namely in Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine & Homoeopathic Philosophy and Case Taking & Repertory affiliated to the University of Calcutta. From 6th batch, 2004-2005 onwards, the Course is affiliated to The West Bengal University of Health Sciences. MD (Hom) in Practice of Medicine, Paediatrics has been introduced from 2009-10 and MD (Hom) in Homoeopathic Pharmacy has been introduced from 2010-11. Both BHMS and MD (Hom) courses are as per the Central Council of Homoeopathy regulations. Total 36 seats are available in the M.D.(Homoeopathy) Course. The distribution of seats in six subjects/disciplines are Materia Medica -09 seats, Repertory – 09 seats, Organon of Medicine – 09 seats, Practice of Medicine – 03 seats, Homoeopathic Pharmacy – 03 seats, Paediatrics – 03 seats.

Reservation of seats for various category of students are as per Govt. of India rules and regulations.

COMMUNITY HEALTH SERVICE & PERIPHERAL OPD

The institute also caters community health services through peripheral OPD situated at Kalyani Herb Garden in the district Nadia. Patient from peripheral OPD are also referred to the Hospital for indoor care and diagnostic purpose.

MEDICAL HERB GARDEN

The herb garden at Kalyani 60 km away from Kolkata was envisaged for building up of repository of authentic specimens of living herbs for research and academic purposes and acclimatization of exotic herbs in the fertile plains of gangetic alluvium in West Bengal in order to develop import substitute for catering to the needs of local pharmaceutical industries as well as export oriented products. The garden spread on about 25 acres of land has grown and maintained 120 different species of medicinal plants including 10 exotic species.

OUR LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SERVICES

This division has more than 21000 documents (macro & micro) including rare homoeopathy treatises. There are 2300 bound journals, 21 periodicals are subscribed regularly and 20 periodicals have been received as gift. It provides various services i.e. Documentation, Reference, Referral, CAS, SDI, Document delivery, Internet etc. to the in-house readers. Book Bank service is also functioning. The department of LIS also provides Information support on Homoeopathy to the Interns, PG students and the Homoeopathic fraternity as a whole.



PUBLICATIONS

The Institute publishes a quarterly bulletin which is incorporating scientific articles by the faculty members, post-graduate trainees, interns, other students and distinguished guest authors. The bulletin received the International Scientific Serial Number (ISSN 0972-6276) early in 2002. Till date Issue up to Volume 18 Number 2 of the bulletin has been published.

A huge number of pamphlet, folder and brochure are published for public awareness.
